

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ART. 13 AND 14 OF THE GDPR REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The Regional Union of the Chambers of Commerce of Veneto (hereinafter, "Unioncamere del Veneto" or "Data Controller") hereby provides the information required by Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (also known as the GDPR or General Data Protection Regulation) regarding the processing of personal data collected and processed within the scope of this procedure.

1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The Data Controller is Unioncamere del Veneto, with registered office in Via delle Industrie 19/D Edificio Lybra, 30174 Venezia-Marghera, VAT n. 02406800272 and tax code 80009100274, website www.ven.camcom.it/index.asp, certified e-mail address: unioncamereveneto@pec.it; Unioncamere appointed the Data Processor, certified e-mail address: rpd@pec.unioncamereveneto.it.

2. Purposes of Processing and Legal Basis

The processing of personal data collected during this procedure is intended for the correct management and execution of the procedure itself, and specifically for the verification and evaluation of technical-professional requirements and other criteria specified in the notice/call.

Data will also be processed to fulfill transparency obligations under Legislative Decree 33/2013 by the Data Controller. The legal basis for such processing is the fulfilment of pre-contractual measures requested by the data subject (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR) and compliance with legal obligations (Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR).

Finally, again for the purposes referred to in the preceding paragraph, the Data Controller may become aware of personal data relating to the existence or absence of criminal convictions, information concerning offences committed or for which the candidate is under investigation, or data relating to the application of security measures. The legal basis for such processing is the fulfilment of legal obligations (Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR and Article 2-octies(3)(a) of Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018).

3. Data acquired from third parties

Unioncamere del Veneto may verify the accuracy of the information provided by the applicant, including by obtaining data from other public authorities (for example, the Public Prosecutor's Office, the courts, the Prefecture, Jobcentres, educational and training institutions, etc.).

4. Natura obbligatoria o facoltativa del conferimento dei dati e conseguenze del mancato conferimento dei dati

Providing data is mandatory for the purposes mentioned in section 2. Total or partial refusal to provide data will result in the impossibility of participating in the procedure.

5. Data conservation period

Personal data will be kept for the duration of the validity of the list/ranking. In the event an employment relationship is established, data will be kept indefinitely.

6. Authorised data controllers

Personal data will be processed internally by personnel designated/authorized for processing. External Data Processors (Art. 28 GDPR) may also process the data, including:

- Suppliers for pre-selection or selection tests.
- Companies providing website services, standard and certified email, technical assistance, and hardware/software maintenance.
- External members of the Selection Committee.

7. Scope of data dissemination

Unioncamere Veneto will publish the data required by current legislation in the "Transparent Administration" section of its institutional website.

8. Data subject's rights

Regulation (EU) 2016/679 grants you, as a data subject, various rights, which may be exercised by contacting the Data Controller or the DPO using the contact details provided in section 1 of this notice.

Among the rights that may be exercised, provided that the conditions laid down by the legislation (in particular, Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation) are met in each case, are:

- the right to know whether Unioncamere del Veneto is currently processing personal data concerning the data subject and, if so, to have access to the data being processed and to all information relating thereto;
- the right to have inaccurate personal data concerning the data subject rectified and/or to have incomplete data completed;
- the right to have personal data concerning the data subject erased;

- the right to restriction of processing;
- the right to object to processing;
- the right to data portability concerning the data subject.

In any case, the data subject also has the right to lodge a formal complaint with the Data Protection Authority, pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR, in accordance with the procedures available on the website: <https://www.garanteprivacy.it>.
