If **comparative federalism** and **intergovernmental relations** is what you deal with in the course of your studies or daily work, we warmly invite you to apply to become a EURAC Federal Scholar.

The yearly '**EURAC Federal Scholar in Residence Programme**' welcomes both academics and practitioners to the Institute for Studies on Federalism and Regionalism at the European Academy of Bolzano/Bozen (EURAC), which is located in South Tyrol (Northern Italy).

Recipients of the programme are granted a **research residency of up to 3 weeks at EURAC**. Travel and accommodation expenses are covered.

The Institute requires **applications** be sent in at the latest by **July 1st** of each year.

Applications must contain an unpublished manuscript (in English, German, Italian, French or Spanish), an abstract in English, a CV and a short motivation letter.

The winner will undertake his/her short residency at EURAC possibly in early February in order to present his/her research during the annual 'International Winter School on Federalism and Governance' (www.eurac.edu/winterschool).
