UPDATE May 19<sup>th</sup>

### ITALY AND FOCUS FOR FRIULI VENEZIA GIULIA REGION

#### MOBILITY OF PRIVATE PERSONS

##### General rules of behaviour:

- obligation to wear masks or nose/mouth protections when outdoors, and to keep at least 1 meter's distance
- it is not necessary to wear masks or nose/mouth protections when driving motor vehicles or motorcycles (with the exception of company vehicles); for children under the age of 6; for people with disabilities not compatible with the continuous use of the mask; in case of staying alone in premises not open to the public; when performing leisure activities in an isolated place or during sport activities in the intense activity phase.
- as of May 18<sup>th</sup>, mobility of people, with public or private means of transport, is allowed inside the whole Region Friuli Venezia Giulia, without self declaration.
- no limit to outdoors leisure activities inside the Region.
- visits to family, relatives and friends are allowed
- grouping of people (if not already living together) is not allowed, nor in private, neither in public places
- residents of the FVG municipalities bordering with Veneto region are allowed to visit relatives in the Veneto municipalities bordering the Region Friuli Venezia Giulia;

##### Entry in Italy

- For Schengen and non-Schengen arrivals, passengers will have to justify the purpose of their trip upon entry. The carrier's staff is required to check the self-certification
- People returning to Italy are obliged to self-isolation, for 14 days after the return, even if asymptomatic compared to COVID-19. It concerns all people who return to Italy by any means of transport. **Self-isolation is not required for those who transit or stop in Italy for proven work needs (e.g. truck drivers), and are still obliged to leave the country within 72 hours of entry, extendable of an additional 48 hours for proven specific needs.** However, for these people, it is mandatory to fill out a declaration stating entry in Italy for the proven working need, and with engagement to immediately report, in the event of the onset of COVID-19 symptoms, the situation to the Department of prevention of local health company and to undergo isolation. These measures **do not apply to traveling personnel of companies having registered offices in Italy, cross-border workers, health services personnel, passenger/freight transport crews.**
- All persons entering Italy, whether at an airport, ferry port or railway station, must avoid using public transport and must therefore make arrangements to be picked up, take a taxi, if and as allowed, or hire a car, with or without a driver

##### Entry in the Region Friuli Venezia Giulia from another Region

- allowed only for well-founded business or work reasons, urgent matters, movement due to health reasons, proved by a self-declaration to provide to police authorities in case of control.

### **Exit from Italy**

- until June 3<sup>rd</sup> travel abroad is not allowed. Exit from Italian territory is allowed, upon certification of valid and urgent reasons, only for work, health reasons or proven needs
- Departures from Italy by plane: most of the flights have been cancelled. Departing passengers will be checked for possession of the travel document, as well as also for the required self-certification.
- From June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2020, without prejudice to the limitations arranged for specific areas of the national territory as well as the limitations arranged in relation to the origin from specific States and territories, movements to and from the following States will not be subject to any limitation: a) States members of the European Union; b) States parties to the Schengen Agreement; c) United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; d) Andorra, Monaco; e) Republic of San Marino and Vatican City State.

### **Passthrough Italy**

- - Transit through Italy, from one foreign country to another, is allowed for specific needs as quickly as possible and without unnecessary stops, for work, medical needs or reasons of absolute necessity

### **Public transport in Friuli Venezia Giulia**

- Public transport (city / intercitybus, trains) works normally, but can be reduced by the provisions of the President of the Region. Essential services are guaranteed. Passengers must wear masks or nose / mouth protectors at stops / stations / bus stations and within local public transport services.

### **MOBILITY OF GOODS**

Transport HUB (airports, ports, inland terminals) : open

Transport by road: allowed. The circulation of goods vehicles heavier than 7.5 tonnes on Italian motorways, usually banned on Holidays, is allowed on Sunday May 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.

Transport by rail: allowed

Transport by sea: allowed

In-home delivery: allowed. On the websites of some municipalities are available the list of in-home delivery companies (es: for Trieste area <https://triestexpress.comune.trieste.it/>)

### **BORDERS ACTIVITIES**

The Italian borders are open for the import or transit of goods.

As regards to the land borders, the staff travelers (Drivers) in charge of the road transport of goods or passengers, employed by companies NOT registered in Italy, must provide a self declaration, indicating:

- the crossing point or border on entry in the Italian territory
- the date and the time of entry.
- the place of destination (the end of the trip to Italy or the foreign country if it is a transit) and the address of the home, dwelling or place where any stay will be made
- the date and the time of exit from the Italian territory

- the reasons for the stay in Italy

The communication must be made to the prevention department of the competent healthcare company based on the place of entry on the national territory. The same communication must be made even if entry into Italy took place only for transit to reach another state (EU or non-EU). In the latter case, the maximum period of stay on the national territory is 24 hours, extendable for specific and proven needs of an additional 12 hours. Beyond this period, the obligations of health surveillance and trust isolation for 14 days apply, simultaneously communicating the circumstance to the competent Health Authority for the territory where isolation is observed.

## **CUSTOMS ACTIVITIES**

Along with the usual custom clearance process for the goods, simplified customs procedure are applied for the import of Personal Protective Equipment – protective masks. The guidelines are published on the Italian Customs Agency website (only in Italian) <https://www.adm.gov.it/portale/istruzioni-per-l-importazione-con-svincolo-diretto-e-celere> and refer to :

- masks categories
- necessary documentation
- tax exemption
- import procedure and conditions for fast release of PPE
